



**Policy**

**2220 Committees of the Board**

The Board may by action establish committees that it determines are necessary to assist the Board in its responsibilities. Any committee established by Board action shall comply with the requirements of the Brown Act and with these policies regarding open meetings.

Board committees that are composed solely of less than a quorum of members of the Board that are advisory are not required to comply with the Brown Act, or with these policies regarding open meetings, unless they are standing committees.

Board committees that are only advisory have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board.

Findings or recommendations shall be reported to the Board for consideration.

The Board has established the following committee(s):

- **Board Finance Standing Committee**

The Board Finance Standing Committee helps the District to monitor its finances and financial condition and report its findings and recommendations to the full Board.

- **Board Policy Standing Committee**

The Board Policy Standing Committee reviews and makes recommendations to the full Board on policies which have gone through our full constituent review process.
