4026 Philosophy and Criteria for International Education

International education should encourage programs that support learning and the exchange of Californians and international students and scholars, for example:

- Courses of study to increase students' understanding of global issues and cultural differences.
- Courses in languages other than English to train students to communicate effectively in other cultures and to enhance their understanding of other nations' values.
- Provide opportunities for students in all majors to participate in study abroad programs to enrich their academic training, perspectives, and personal development.
- Provide opportunities for domestic and international students to interact effectively and routinely share their views, perceptions, and experiences in educational settings.
- Develop innovative public educational forums and venues to explore global issues and showcase world cultures.

For international students and scholars,

- Encourage the presence of qualified students from other countries to inspire an appreciation for differences among cultures and a deeper understanding of the values and perspectives of other people.
- Facilitate faculty exchange and collaborative partnership programs with institutions in other countries.
- Initiate collaborative research undertakings.
- Recruit and retain the world's best and brightest faculty to educate California's students as globally aware citizens.
