Administrative Procedure

5570 Student Credit Card Solicitations

The procedures for student credit card solicitation include the following:

- Credit card solicitation is limited to twice a year during scheduled vendor fairs.
- Vendors should be registered with campus administration (Campus Life Office).
- Marketers of student credit cards are prohibited from offering gifts to students for filling out credit card applications.
- Credit card and debt education and counseling sessions will be offered to students.
